

Baro'o Kogen Camp site

Precautions for use

The Baro'o Kogen camp site is managed with as little maintenance as possible in order for you to fully enjoy the natural environment at the foot of Ariake Mountains.

We are making every effort to ensure the safety of our campsites.

We are making every effort to manage the campground safely.

Please understand that you are in the midst of nature, and enjoy camping at your own risk.

Please enjoy camping at your own risk. (There is no resident caretaker.)

We ask for a minimum cooperation fee of 200 yen per person per day of use.
(This will be used for conservation and maintenance of the facility.)

Reservations and applications must be made in advance. Please display the permit given to you at the time of application in your vehicle or at the campsite. (No use without a permit.) Auto camping is not allowed in areas other than the designated areas. Please park your vehicle in the parking space in front of the site.

Please take back any garbage and extinguishers generated during use by yourselves.

Toilet and water facilities are available, but the water is well water and not suitable for drinking. Parking and camping spaces are not demarcated. Please use these spaces while coordinating with other users. The adjacent regulating pond is an important facility that supplies water to the rice paddies downstream.

Please do not enter the pond. Please refrain from any activities that may cause inconvenience to other users.

The mountain is a habitat for wildlife, so please take care of your own food.

We recommend that you carry a bell to repel bears. Please be careful when handling fire (e.g., burning surrounding plants) in this mountainous area. Please refrain from collecting natural materials (plants, trees, rocks, etc.) around the campground.

The area around the campground is designated as a mudslide warning area.

The area around the campground is designated as a mudslide warning area. If any of the following is issued or announced for Matsukawa Village the campground will be closed to visitors. (weather warnings such as heavy rain and flood warnings, landslide warning information, and evacuation information)

The Ashima River can suddenly rise. Please pay close attention to the river conditions.

The facility may be closed without notice due to weather conditions, spread of infectious diseases, facility construction, or other unavoidable reasons.

Closed during the winter season. (December - April)
